Network Deficiencies

Unless otherwise noted, WellCare has contacted every provider listed below to address a deficiency, and those providers have indicated willingness to contract with WellCare post CCN award.

Network Deficiencies in all GSAs

- Neonatology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Livingston, St. Helena, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, St. Martin, St. Mary, Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Catahoula, Cameron, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Red River, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, Webster, West Carroll and Winn parishes. This deficiency will be addressed in Livingston and St. Helena parishes by eventually contracting with Baton Rouge Neonatal Associates which represents the current standard of care in these parishes. These deficiencies in East Baton Rouge and East Feliciana parishes will be addressed by eventually contracting with Baton Rouge Neonatal Associates which represents the current standard of care in these parishes. For St. Martin parish the standard of care is referral to Lafayette or St. Landry parish which we meet network adequacy for this specialty. For St. Mary parish, the standard of care is referral to Iberia or Terrebonne parish which we meet network adequacy for this specialty. For Rapides parish, Dr. Joyner and Dr. Schroeder were contacted and have not yet made a decision regarding participation. The standard pattern of care in other parishes in GSA C is referral to the LSU Network in Shreveport.
- Nuclear Medicine – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Livingston, St. Helena, Washington Acadia, Ascension, Assumption, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Lafayette, Point Coupee, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, Vermillion, West Baton Rouge, West Feliciana and all other GSA C parishes. This deficiency will be addressed in Livingston, St. Helena, Ascension, Assumption, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberville, Point Coupee, West Baton Rouge and West Feliciana parishes by eventually contracting with Nuclear Medicine Associates which represents the current standard of care in these parishes. This deficiency will be addressed in Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermillion parishes by contracting with Mian Ibrahim, MD, in Lafayette Parish which represents the current standard of care in this parish. This deficiency will be addressed in Washington parish by eventually contracting with North Shore Imaging Associates, which represents the current standard of care in this parish. In GSA C we will continue to work with hospitals to identify Nuclear Medicine groups to add to the network post award.
- Pediatrics, Allergy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Livingston, St. Helena, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, West Feliciana Bossier, Caddo, Caldwell, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, West Carroll and Winn parishes. This deficiency will be addressed in Livingston and St. Helena parishes by eventually contracting with FMOL Physician Group. Currently, Ochsner's John Erffmeyer, MD, Allergist, agrees to see children at his Baton Rouge Ochsner office locations. Baton Rouge Clinic does not accept Medicaid. We additionally

have GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in St. Martin parish and members can seek care in Lafayette Parish and a deficiency in St. Mary parish where members can seek care in Iberia Parish. In the parishes of Catahoula, Concordia, LaSalle, Grant, Winn, and Vernon, the pattern of care is referral to Rapides parish physicians which meet network adequacy in this specialty. In the remainder of GSA C the standard pattern of care for these parishes is referral to LSU physicians.

- Surgery – Cardiovascular – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Livingston, St. Helena, Washington, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, St. Martin, St. Mary, West Feliciana, Allen, Avoyelles, Caldwell, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, West Carroll, and Winn parishes. This deficiency will be addressed in Livingston and St. Helena parishes by eventually contracting with CVT Surgical Associates, Vascular Surgery Associates or the Vascular Clinic in Baton Rouge. This deficiency will be addressed in Washington parish by eventually contracting with Northshore Surgical in Covington, LA (St. Tammany Parish). St. Martin parish standard of care is referral to Lafayette or St. Landry parishes and St. Mary parish standard of care is referral to Iberia or Terrebonne parishes (network adequacy has been met in this specialty). In Rapides parish we have contacted Richard Williams M.D., Henry Hanley M.D. and Navtej Rangi M.D. and in Vernon parish we have contacted Jose Matthew M.D.
- Surgery – Colon and Rectal – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Washington, Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, Vermilion parishes. In GSA C there are GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in all parishes except Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Claiborne, Desoto, Red River and Webster This deficiency will be addressed by eventually contracting with Northshore Surgical in Covington, LA. We have been in contact with this group and they indicate their willingness to consider contracting with WellCare post award. In GSA B we have been in contact with Kenneth Champagne, MD, who has indicated willingness to consider contracting with WellCare post award. We have contacted Mark Rubin, MD in Ouachita Parish and Joseph Marrasso, MD in Rapides Parish. The balance of the other GSA C parishes will seek care through LSU physicians.
- Ambulance Services – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Washington, Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette and Vermilion parish, to be addressed by contracting with Acadian Ambulance.

GSA A Network Deficiencies

- Physical Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Washington Parish. This deficiency is now addressed with the addition of Riverside Rehab facility which is a part of contracted Riverside Medical Center. We continue to identify private therapy companies and home health agencies to add access to care.
- Private Physical Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Washington Parish. This deficiency is now addressed with the addition of Riverside Rehab facility which is a part of contracted Riverside Medical Center. We continue to identify private therapy companies and home health agencies to add access to care.
- Private Speech Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Washington Parish. This deficiency is now addressed with the addition of Riverside Rehab facility which is a part

of contracted Riverside Medical Center. We continue to identify private therapy companies and home health agencies to add access to care.

GSA B Network Deficiencies

- Dermatology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, and Vermilion parishes in GSA B. These deficiencies will be addressed by eventually contracting with one or all of the following dermatologists: Ronald Daigle, M.D., Jennifer Labiche, MD, Christopher Hubbell, MD, in Lafayette, LA.
- Endocrinology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Acadia, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberia, Lafayette, Point Coupee, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, Vermilion, West Baton Rouge and West Feliciana parishes in GSA B. The standard pattern of care in East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Pointe Coupee, West Baton Rouge and West Feliciana parishes is referral to Dr. Rajat Bushan or to LSU. For parishes of Acadia, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary and Vermilion parishes, these deficiencies will be addressed with the contracting of Ghys Rizek, MD, Lafayette, LA.
- Gastroenterology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Evangeline parish in GSA B. The standard pattern of care in this parish is referral to Opelousas, LA (St. Landry Parish.) We have received LOIs for gastroenterologists in St. Landry Parish.
- Pediatric Cardiology – We have GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana and St. Martin and St. Mary parishes. For East Baton Rouge and East Feliciana parishes, the current standard of care is referral to either Pediatric Cardiology Associates or LSU who are both located in East Baton Rouge parish. For St. Martin parish, the current standard of care is to Lafayette Parish and for St. Mary parish the current standard of care is to Iberia or Terrebonne parishes. Statewide network adequacy for this specialty has been met.
- Pulmonology – We have GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Evangeline, Lafayette and Vermilion parishes. The current standard of care in these parishes is referral to either Richard Fei, MD, Fadi Malek, MD, Walter Brown, MD or Billy Rosson, MD.
- Rheumatology Specialty – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Evangeline parish. Current standard of care for the parish refers to St. Landry, which meets specialty network adequacy.
- Surgery Pediatric – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Acadia, Assumption, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Lafayette, Point Coupee, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, Vermilion and West Baton Rouge parishes. These deficiencies will be addressed in Assumption, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberville, Pointe Coupee and West Baton Rouge parishes by eventually contracting with Pediatric Surgery of Louisiana which represents the current standard of care in these parishes. These deficiencies will be addressed in Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermilion parishes with the contracting of Kenneth Falterman, MD, HCA physician, in Lafayette, LA which represents the current standard of care in this parish.
- Surgery - Plastic – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Acadia, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Lafayette, Point Coupee, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, Vermillion, West Baton Rouge and West Feliciana parishes. These include James Wade, MD, Michael Haneman, JR. MD, Gary Cox, MD, John Dean, MD, James Stephens, MD, Ann Reilly, MD in East Baton Rouge Parish and Louis Mes, MD,

Kenneth Odinet, MD, Russell Romero, MD and Darrell Henderson, MD, in Lafayette Parish.

- Surgery – Thoracic – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Pointe Coupee and West Feliciana parishes. Current standard of care refers to East Baton Rouge parish which meets network adequacy in this specialty.
- Urology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary and Vermilion parishes. We have been in contact with Frank Bacque, MD, Jeanette Chassignac, MD, Scott Neustetzer, MD, Martin Ducote, MD and William Roth, MD. We also have a GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in St. John the Baptist parish. The current standard of care refers to Lafourche parish which meets network adequacy for this specialty.

GSA C Network Deficiencies

- Allergy and Immunology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Grant, Natchitoches, Rapides, Sabine, Tensas, Vernon, West Carroll and Winn parishes in GSA C. The standard pattern of care in Allen, Beuregard, Calcasieu, Cameron and Jefferson Davis parishes is referral to Calcasieu parish. We have contacted Richard Kent, MD and he is on extended Medical Leave. The other physician, Martin Miller, MD, does not accept Medicaid. In the interim, members are being referred to Lafayette Parish. For the parishes of Catahoula and Concordia, Tensas, the standard pattern of care is to John White, MD, ENT or Barry Tillman, Pulmonary Medicine. These physicians also offer allergy testing and treatment and have signed LOIs with WellCare. In the parish of Sabine, the member will access specialty care in Desoto Parish and West Carroll parish will seek care in Ouachita Parish. Network adequacy is met in all of these parishes. We will continue to contract physicians in the other parishes for this specialty.
- Anesthesiology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Cameron, Claiborne, Desoto, East Carroll, Red River and Webster, West Carroll parishes in GSA C. The provider based anesthesia services have been contacted associated with hospitals in these parishes.
- Audiology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Concordia, East Carroll, Sabine, West Carroll and Tensas parishes. The standard pattern of care is to John White, MD for Concordia and Tensas parishes. Dr. White's LOI came in after the GeoAccess adequacy mapping was run. East Carroll, Sabine, West Carroll standard of care is to the ENT/OTOL provider in their respective parish in which network adequacy has been met.
- Chiropractic – GeoAccess adequacy deficiency in Cameron, East Carroll, Natchitoches, Sabine, Tensas and Vernon parishes. Multiple providers have been contacted and will consider contracting with WellCare post award.
- Dermatology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, Jefferson Davis, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, West Carroll and Winn parishes in GSA C. All providers under this specialty contacted chose not to sign LOIs and will consider contracting with WellCare post award. In Rapides parish, Dr. Lewis does not accept Medicaid. In Calcasieu, Imperial Calcasieu Medical Group was non-responsive and continued follow-up will be made.

- Emergency Medicine – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in East Carroll, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Richland, Tensas, Union, and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. The provider based Emergency Medicine services have been contacted associated with hospitals in these parishes.
- Endocrinology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Jackson, Jefferson Davis, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. In Calcasieu and Cameron parish, Dr. Gilbert does not accept Medicaid any longer and Dr. Paraguya is with the LSU system. The standard of care will be referral to LSU physicians.
- Gastroenterology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Madison, Tensas, and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. In Catahoula and Concordia parishes, members will seek care with C.R. Tillman, MD, whose LOI was returned after GeoAccess mapping was completed, For East Carroll and Madison parishes, the standard of care will be referral to providers in Ouachita parish and for Tensas parish the standard pattern of care will be for referral to Franklin parish. In both of these parishes network adequacy has been met.
- Hematology / Oncology Disease – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Avoyelles, Caldwell, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, West Carroll and Winn parishes in GSA C. The standard pattern of care in Avoyelles and LaSalle parish is referral to Rapides parish for care. In Catahoula and Concordia parishes, referral is to Cancer Care Center in Natchez, MS. The other parishes seek care in Shreveport through the LSU physicians.
- Infectious Disease – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Beauregard, Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Jackson, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Red River, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Webster and Winn parishes in GSA C. In Rapides parish, Dr. Veroqua has submitted his LOI and is not reflected in the GeoAccess mapping due to the date it was received. In Calcasieu, Cameron, Beauregard, Allen and Jefferson Davis parishes, Dr. Ruiz is the only physician and is part of the LSU system. In Caddo, Bossier, Bienville, Natchitoches, Red River, Sabine, Desoto and Claiborne, the standard pattern of care is through LSU Shreveport.
- Nephrology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Catahoula, Cameron, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, LaSalle,, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, , Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, West Carroll and Winn parishes in GSA C. In Calcasieu, Cameron, Beauregard, Allen, Jefferson Davis, we contacted Dr. Abushamat and Dr. Aliaboni.
- Neurology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Calcasieu, , Catahoula, Cameron, Concordia, East Carroll, Grant, Madison, Natchitoches, Rapides, Sabine, Tensas, Vernon and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. In Rapides, Avoyelles, Catahoula, Grant, LaSalle, Winn and Vernon parishes the specialty referral pattern is to HCA neurologists. In addition, in Catahoula and Concordia parishes, Dr. Anuba Jati has been contacted. In Calcasieu, Cameron, Beauregard, Allen, we have contacted Imperial Calcasieu Medical Group and they have not made decision to date to participate.

- Occupational Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Beuregard, Bossier, Caddo, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, Webster and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. We will continue to contract with independent therapy companies and home health agencies to provide these services.
- Ophthalmology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, East Carroll, Natchitoches, Sabine, Tensas and Vernon parishes. Additional providers are being contacted to provide vision care.
- Orthopedics – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Avoyelles, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll and Tensas parishes in GSA C. For Catahoula, Concordia and Tensas parishes, we have received a recent LOI from J. H. Fairbanks, M.D. that is not included in GeoAccess mapping. For Avoyelles Parish, the pattern of care is referral to Rapides parish physicians and this parish meets network adequacy for this specialty. For East Carroll parish, pattern of care is referral to Ouachita parish physicians and this parish meets network adequacy for this specialty.
- Otolaryngology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Catahoula, Concordia, Grant and Tensas parishes in GSA C. For the parishes of Catahoula, Concordia and Tensas parishes, the pattern of care is referral to John White, MD, who has just signed a LOI and is not reflected in GeoAccess mapping. For Grant parish, standard pattern of care is to Rapides parish physicians which meets network adequacy for this specialty.
- Pathology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Concordia, East Carroll, Natchitoches, Sabine, Tensas and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. The provider based pathology services have been contacted associated with hospitals in these parishes to consider contracting with WellCare post award.
- Pediatrics, Cardiology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Caldwell, Catahoula, Claiborne, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Red River, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, Webster, West Carroll and Winn parishes in GSA C The standard pattern of care for these parishes is referral to LSU physicians.
- Physical Therapy – Geo adequacy deficiency in Beuregard, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. The standard pattern of care for these parishes is to the parish hospitals. We continue to contract with independent physical therapy clinics and home health agencies for these services.
- Podiatry – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Cameron, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Red River, Tensas and Webster parishes in GSA C. In Cameron parish, pattern of care is referral to specialists in Calcasieu parish where network adequacy has been met. In parishes of East Carroll, Tensas and West Carroll parishes, the pattern of care is referral to specialists in Ouachita parish where network adequacy in this parish has been met. In parishes of Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Desoto, Red River and Webster, we have contacted numerous providers in this specialty. In Concordia parish, we have contacted Richard Myers, MD in Natchez, MS.

- Private Occupational Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Beuregard, Bossier, Caddo, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, Webster and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. We will continue to contract with independent therapy companies and home health agencies to provide these services.
- Private Physical Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Beauregard, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, West Carroll parishes within GSA C. We will continue to contract independent therapy companies and home health agencies to provide these services.

We will continue to contract independent therapy companies and home health agencies to provide these services.

For Allen parish, members can seek care in Calcasieu parish and network adequacy has been met in that parish. In Avoyelles, Rapides and Vernon parishes the current standard of care is to seek care through HCA physicians. Pulmonary physicians in the remaining parishes have been contacted.
- Radiology – Diagnostic – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Cameron Parish. These services are provided in Calcasieu parish and network adequacy has been met in that parish.
- Radiology – Therapeutic – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Bossier, Caddo, Caldwell, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Ouachita, Richland, Tensas, Union, Webster and West Carroll parishes. These services are provided by LSU and Christus Health System.
- Rheumatology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Caldwell, Catahoula, Concordia, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, West Carroll and Winn parishes in GSA C. These services are provided by LSU physicians for parishes other than Rapides. In Rapides parish, services are provided through HCA physicians.
- Speech Therapy – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Beuregard, Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Red River, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, Webster, West Carroll and Winn parishes. These services are offered at many of the parish hospitals. We continue to contract independent therapy clinic and home health agencies to provide these services.

- Surgery – Neurological – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Allen, Avoyelles, Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Caldwell, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Franklin, Grant, Jackson, LaSalle, Lincoln, Madison, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, Red River, Richland, Sabine, Tensas, Union, Vernon, Webster, West Carroll and Winn parishes. In Rapides, contact was attempted with Dr. Barker and Dr. Doud and no response has been given. The balance of the other parishes will seek care through LSU physicians.
- Surgery – Pediatric – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in all parishes except Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Claiborne, Desoto, Red River and Webster are deficient. These parishes will seek care through LSU physicians.

Physicians in these parishes were contacted .
- Surgery – Thoracic – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Bossier, Caddo, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Madison, Red River, Sabine, Tensas, Webster and West Carroll parishes in GSA C. Thoracic Surgery Physicians have been contacted.
- Urology – GeoAccess adequacy deficiencies in Avoyelles, Bossier, Caddo, Concordia, Desoto, East Carroll, Grant, Red River, Tensas, Webster, and West Carroll parishes. Urology physicians contacted include Signature Urology, Shreveport, LA, for Bossier, Caddo, Desoto Red River and Webster parishes and contact has been made with hospital contracted urologists that make visits to rural hospitals monthly. Avoyelles parish members seek care from urologists in Rapides parish, which meets GeoAccess adequacy in this specialty.
